When changing a bulb, always switch off at the mains and allow the old bulb to cool down before handling.

Dispose of used bulbs carefully and responsibly.

This product is not suitable for dimming.

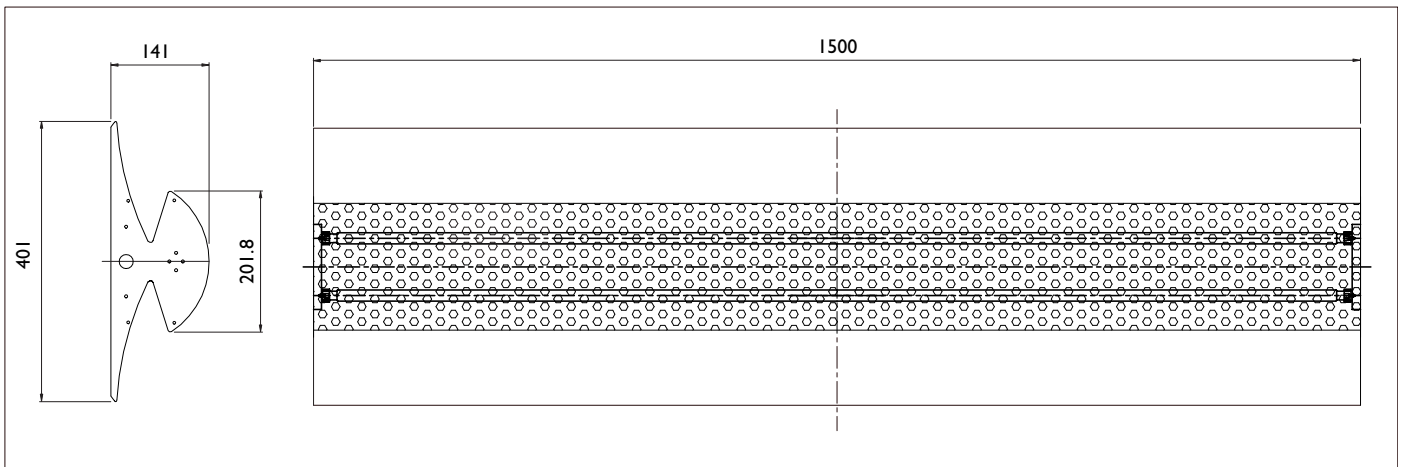

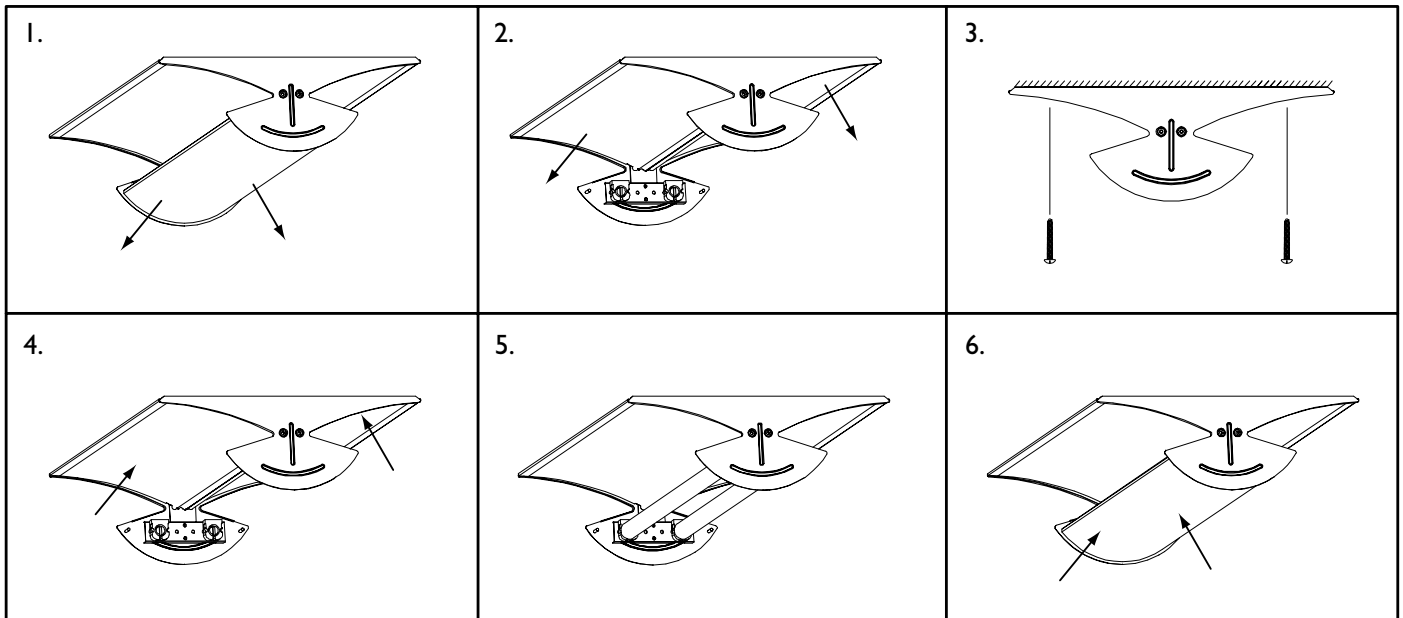

Installation

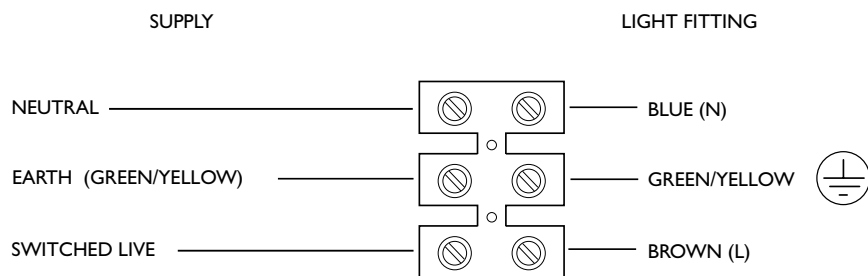
Existing fittings must be completely removed before installation of a new product. Before removing the existing fitting, **carefully note the position of each set of wires.**

1. Remove the lower reflector board and set aside. See Figure 1. Remove the two upper reflector boards and set aside. See Figure 2.
2. With an assistant, hold the product in place and mark the position of the holes. See Figure 3.
3. Ensure the ceiling is capable of holding the weight of the product. Take care to avoid damaging any concealed wiring and pipes. The correct fixings should be used for brick, cavity walls or plasterboard.
4. Fix into position. See Figure 3.



Wiring

Having correctly identified the wiring from your existing light fitting, pull the wire through the hole and connect to the connection block inside the product in the following way:



Check That

- You have correctly identified the wires.
- The connections are tight.
- No loose strands have been left out of the connection block.

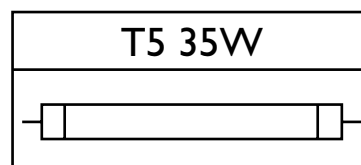
Commissioning

6. Adjust the cable so it does not get snagged.
7. Refit the upper reflector boards. See Figure 4.
8. Fit the correct lamp as detailed below, See Figure 5.
9. Refit the lower reflector board. See Figure 4.
10. Replace fuse or circuit breaker and switch on. Your light is now ready for use.

Fitting / Replacing Bulbs

When changing a bulb, always switch off at the mains and allow the bulb to cool before handling. Used bulbs should not be disposed of with household waste. Please recycle where facilities exist. Always use the correct type and wattage bulb. Using the incorrect wattage bulb will damage the bulb and ballast.
